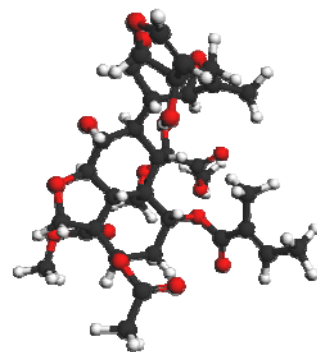

Guidelines for abstract submission

Since abstracts will be processed as received, all authors are responsible for providing complete and accurate abstracts.

Text should contain Title in bold; names of authors (speaker's name underlined); address (es) with details of authors' affiliations and the speaker's e-mail, and body text on W21 x 29.5 cm (A4) paper with a margin of 3 cm on the top, 2 cm at the bottom, and 2.5 cm on the right and left. The abstract should be formatted using "Times New Roman" font throughout, single-spaced paragraphs, capitalized titles using 14 pt. type, and 12 pt. type for the body text Word limit for the abstract is 300 words. Once the abstract is submitted, changes, corrections or rewording are possible until deadline of abstract submission (December 31, 2011). Please send the abstract to: isnpmp2012@gmail.com
